## Activity:

Please try to keep Zaylee calm this evening. Restrict access to stairs and furniture this evening. Monitor your pet closely so she does not fall.

## Diet:

Please only offer a small amount of water when you get home. Make sure your pet does not seem nauseous (i.e., drooling, licking/ smacking lips, vomiting). Wait about 20 minutes before offering a small amount of food. If your pet wants more food and seems to be feeling well enough, you can offer another small amount of food after waiting another 20 minutes. Zaylee can eat and drink normally the following morning.
